

# STANDARD RESIDENTIAL BUYER INSPECTION AGREEMENT

**SCOPE OF THE INSPECTION:** The real estate inspection to be performed for Client(s) is a non-invasive physical examination, performed for the fee set forth below, designed to identify material defects in the systems, structures, and components of the above-referenced primary building and its associated primary parking structure as they exist at the time of the inspection. A material defect is a condition that significantly affects the value, desirability, habitability or safety of the building. Style or aesthetics shall not be considered in determining whether a specific system, structure, or component is defective. The inspection shall be limited to those specific systems, structures, and components that are present and visually accessible. Components and systems shall be operated with normal user controls only and as conditions permit. The inspection will be performed in accordance with the Standards of Practice of the California Real Estate Inspection Association ("CREIA") in effect at the time of this inspection. A copy of the CREIA Standards is available upon request. This inspection is not intended to be technically exhaustive. Inspector shall prepare a written inspection report for the sole use and benefit of Client(s). The inspection report shall describe and identify the inspected systems, structures, and components of the building and shall identify material defects in those systems, structures, and components observed during the inspection. Client(s) agrees to read the entire inspection report when it is received and shall promptly call the Inspector with any questions or concerns Client(s) may have regarding the real estate inspection or the inspection report. In addition by signing this agreement you authorize Brink's Home Security to call you at the phone number you have provided to discuss a special system offer.

**ENVIRONMENTAL CONCERNS:** Client(s) acknowledges what is being contracted for is a building inspection and not an environmental evaluation and the inspection is not intended to; detect, identify or disclose any health or environmental concerns regarding the building(s) and/or adjacent property, including, but not limited to, the presence of asbestos, radon, lead, urea-formaldehyde, fungi, mold, mildew, bio-organic growth, PCBs, or any other toxic materials or substances contained in the water, air, soils, or building materials or products.

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Services for inspecting or evaluating the excluded items listed above may be available from the Inspector for an additional fee or from specialists qualified to inspect or evaluate a particular category or item. Inspector is a home inspection generalist and is not acting as an expert in any craft or trade. The inspection report may contain recommendations for further evaluation by an individual other than Inspector herein who is qualified as an expert or specialist. If Inspector recommends consulting other specialized experts, Client(s) agrees to do so at their own expense. It is Client's duty and obligation to exercise reasonable care to protect himself or herself regarding the condition of the subject property, including those facts which are known to or within the diligent attention and observation of Client.

The finished inspection report will be sent via email. A hard (black and white) copy of the report can be sent to the buyer by snail mail for a nominal fee of \$20.00 dollars. Inspector must be informed and the additional fee paid at the time of the inspection

CLIENT(S) AGREES TO INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD INSPECTOR HARMLESS FROM ANY THIRD PARTY CLAIMS ARISING OUT OF CLIENT'S UNAUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTION OF THE INSPECTION REPORT.

**SEVERABILITY:** Should any provision of this contract be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be either invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of this contract shall remain in full force and effect, unimpaired by the court's holding.

**ARBITRATION:** Any dispute concerning the interpretation of this Agreement or arising from this inspection and report, except one for inspection fee payment, shall be resolved between the parties by binding arbitration conducted in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association except that the parties shall select an arbitrator who is familiar with the home inspection industry .

The parties hereto shall be entitled to all discovery rights and legal motions as provided in the California Code of Civil Procedure. The arbitrator shall apply the substantive and procedural laws of the State of California to all issues submitted in the arbitration proceeding. The award of the arbitrator shall be final, and a judgment may be entered on it by any court having jurisdiction.

**GENERAL PROVISIONS:** This inspection contract, the real estate inspection, and the inspection report do not constitute a home warranty, guarantee, or insurance policy of any kind whatsoever. The real estate inspection and inspection report are not a substitute disclosure for real estate transactions which may be required by law. No legal action or proceeding of any kind, including those sounding in tort or contract, can be commenced against Inspector/Inspection Company, or its officers, agents or employees more than one year from the date of the home inspection. In no event shall the time for commencement of legal action or proceeding exceed one year from the date of the subject inspection. THIS TIME PERIOD IS SHORTER THAN OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW. In the event Client(s) discovers a material defect or other deficiency that was not identified and reported by Inspector, Client(s) shall so notify Inspector in writing and allow Inspector and/or Inspector's designated representative to re-inspect and document the condition(s) of the material defect or deficiency prior to making any repair, alteration or replacement to said material defect or deficiency.

- The written report to be prepared by Inspector shall be considered the final and exclusive findings of the Inspector regarding the inspection of the property.
- Client(s) shall not rely on any oral statements made by the Inspector prior to issuance of the written report.
- This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their heirs, successors and assigns.

This agreement constitutes the entire integrated agreement between the parties hereto pertaining to the subject matter hereof, and may be modified only by a written agreement signed by all of the parties hereto. No oral agreements, understandings, or representations shall change, modify, or amend any part of this agreement. Each party signing this Agreement warrants and represents that he/she has the full capacity and authority to execute this Agreement on behalf of the named party. If this Agreement is executed on behalf of Client(s) by any third party, the person executing this Agreement expressly represents to Inspector that he/she has the full and complete authority to execute this Agreement on Client's behalf and to fully and completely bind Client(s) to all of the terms, conditions, limitations, exceptions and exclusions of this Agreement.

**ACCEPTANCE OF REPORT AND FEE PAYMENT:** The fee for this inspection is due at the time of the inspection. If CLIENT(S) does not attend the inspection, the fee is due upon receipt of the report. If the CLIENT(S) has not signed this agreement, the acceptance of this report shall constitute agreement with all of the terms of this contract. The printed or emailed report to be prepared by INSPECTOR shall be considered the final and exclusive findings of the INSPECTOR regarding the inspection of the property. CLIENT(S) shall not rely on any oral statements made by the INSPECTOR prior to issuance of the printed or emailed report. In the event CLIENT(S) fails to pay any amount due hereunder and it becomes necessary for the our company to take action in a court of law to collect such sums, CLIENT(S) shall be responsible for all costs and reasonable attorney's fees incurred by the our company.

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**ACCEPTANCE OF THIS AGREEMENT:** This agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto, their heirs, successors, assigns, agents, and representatives of any kind whatsoever.
